

Launch of Book

AFRICA: ON THE CUSP OF AN ECONOMIC MIRACLE





The main focus of this symposium is on the content of the book, by the same title, based on an initial White Paper drafted by Yelang Prue Jinka. "AFRICA: On the Cusp of an Economic Miracle" outlines 7 specific areas where Africa has an advantage, limited only by how soon we act on that advantage, and whether or not we do so positively.

Day 1 of the Symposium will be a presentation by both Yelang Prue Jinka and Charlotte Kemp, on the topic, with examples, stories and statistics.

- Day 2 will see participants workshopping the content of Day 1, using specific futures models and tools that will teach them how to use Futures Thinking for decision making and policy development. These tools will be available as a kit for each Company to pass this skill set on to team back home.
- Day 3 will allow delegates to explore some specific examples of futures focussed businesses in Cape Town, with a focus on science, agriculture and education. This day trip will introduce innovative ideas, encouragement on the pursuit of ground breaking projects, and allow for a sharing of conversation which will help to reinforce the learnings of the previous two days.
